BELLEVUE, Smetanovo nábř. 18, Praha 1, 110 00

Bellevue invites to **elegant atmosphere, excellent food**. You will be assisted by knowledgeable, experienced and attentive wait staff. The **panoramic view** through the front, corner windows here take in a truly masterful composition which includes: the **Vltava river, Charles Bridge** and the ever present **Prague Castle**. BILKOVA 13, Bílkova 13 | 110 00 Praha 1


DUPLEX RESTAURANT, Václavské náměstí 21, Praha 1


KAMPA PARK, Na Kampě 8b, Praha 1

Here, on a small peninsula jutting out into the Vltava River, the setting is impressive. Guests dine **alongside the river** in a heated, covered, terrace. PILSNER RESTAURANT IN THE MUNICIPAL HOUSE, Náměstí Republiky 1090/5, Staré Město, Praha 1

This restaurant in **Art Nouveau style** is situated in the building of Obecní Dům (Municipal House) in the centre of Prague. The Pilsner Restaurant has the **typical old Prague atmosphere**. Its interior is decorated by ceramic mosaics and it belongs to the **most beautiful art nouveau beer restaurants in the central Europe**. It is located at the lower level of the Municipal House. VILLA RICHTER RESTAURANT, Staré zámecké schody 6/251, Prague Castle 118 00 Praha

Welcome to a unique gastronomical complex of three diverse restaurants, which is located in the middle of one of the oldest vineyards in Bohemia in the vicinity of Prague Castle. At the traditional Villa staterooms you can enjoy the feeling of cosiness and a charm of the old times with amazing views. Performances in Prague, September 22nd

The National Theatre; Radúz and Mahulena, Drama, Julius Zeyer, 07:00 pm

Zeyer's dramatic poem is one of the most beautiful love stories to have graced a Czech stage. Classical fairy-tale motifs wed with mythological references joined together with bravado through a metaphorical language. Radúz and Mahulena, from feuding kingdoms, surmount on behalf of their love not only the wiles of fate, but also the sorceries of Queen Runa, burning with hate. Zeyer gave his play the subheading "A Slovak fairy tale in four acts" and the splendid prologue "I am a fairy tale. I will lead those who join me to the blue lands of fable..." Besides Slovak myths and fairy tales, he also drew upon the Indian drama Sakuntala by the poet Kalidasa. In doing so, he created an exceptionally impressive work whose centre of gravity is the power of the word augmented by abundant symbolism of colours and natural elements.



The Estates Theatre; Frida, Ballet, 08:00 pm



The New Stage; What Happened after Nora Left Her Husband, Drama, Elfriede Jelinek, 7:00 pm

The Nobel Prize winner writes provocatively and her relentless criticism even surpasses that of Ibsen. (Two of the plays Jelinek links up to are contained in the title.) Above all, she conjectures the story of Nora. As the author has herself said, she considers Nora an extremely negative character. Although Nora extricated herself from her marriage, she continues, like a squirrel, hopping around seeking to please men, without understanding any of the principles of the civilisation dictated by males. (Those who exploit more effectively, compete more effectively, is how her algorithm could read.) Jelinek sends Nora to the 1930s, the years of economic crisis with war on the horizon. As Václav Bělohradský would put it, it is an apposite metaphor of the time of the deified growth of Growth.



Black Theatre Image; Afrikania,

The performance Afrikania tells about a meeting of a married couple during their exotic holiday with a postman who finds himself unexpectedly in the position of a reception clerk of an abandoned hotel. The story blends together with impressive images of the region Afrikania, full of varied animal kinds to which the newest black theatre technique, non-traditional costumes and professional dancing performances breathe in life. Theatre designing inspired by nature and the projection surrounding the spectator put the finishing touches to the atmosphere of this fantasy world, to which we invite you for a non-traditional trip.



RECOMMENDED CLUBS

DUPLEX CLUB

Location: Wenceslas square

Duplex Dance Club & Café Bar in Prague enjoys a terrific position on the top floor of a large building, right in the center of Wenceslas Square. By day, Duplex is a great place to grab a coffee and a snack and to enjoy the views over the whole square. At night, it transforms into one of Prague's most exclusive nightclubs, with cool lighting and some of Prague's best DJ's. Look up from Wenceslas Square and you'll see the exterior, designed to resemble a giant glass cube. At night you may even be able to make out the dancers as the lights illuminate them in the windows. As well as five bars and two chill-out areas, Duplex has a roof terrace offering superb views over the city. The tunes are good and the interior is very stylish, with comfy sofas from which you can watch the dancers, or to recline in after joining them on the dance floor. With its late closing time, Duplex is a great place to top off your night and to start the next morning. Entrance fee depends on the actual programme.

Maximum capacity of the club is approx. 900 persons.



CLUB LAVKA, Lávka 1, Praha 1

Location: Close to the Charles Bridge

Lavka is situated on the right side banks of the River Vltava, next to Charles Bridge, and offers stunning views of Prague Castle. This supreme location attracts tourists as well as Czechs who consider this as good club to party the night away in. The music is hardly cutting edge, more party music - Lavka covers everything from 60's to today's best dance tunes. In the summer Lavka's great terrace at the rear is packed with revellers, enjoying the views over the water, the cool draught Pilsner & swaying to the music. Daytime, Lavka transforms itself into a restaurant and a bar – a place, where you can enjoy a pleasant meal and a drink by the river. As well as the tables on the terrace at the back, there is also an outside restaurant in the front of the place, by the water break. Entrance fee depends on the actual programme.

Maximum capacity of the club is 800 persons (in summer); 450 persons (in winter).



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
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LA FABRIQUE, Uhelný trh 2, Praha 1

Location: Walking distance from Narodni trida or National Theatre

A swish complex of large underground rooms sets the scene for the La Fabrique's definition of a music club. The hordes of uniformed employees are friendly and efficient. Downstairs, the dance floor is packed with a mixture of expats and Czechs doing the meat-market disco stomp to whatever weird mixture the DJ (who couldn't gauge the atmosphere of a morgue) serves up to them.



REDUTA JAZZ CLUB, Národní 20, Praha 1

Jazz Club Reduta was founded in 1958 and it is one of the oldest and best known jazz clubs. It is located on Národní street which is just a few minutes walk from the National Theatre or from the bottom part of the Wenceslas square. The interior is simple, with pictures of jazz greats adorning the walls. It has an intimate feeling, with a small stage very close to the audience. Reduta Jazz Club is a place which saw the former American president Bill Clinton featuring a jam session with former Czech president Václav Havel. Nightly live jazz performances start at 9:30 p.m. Advanced booking is available from 3 p.m.



AGHARTA JAZZ CENTRE, Železná 16, Praha 1

Are you that kind of person whose head automatically turns when the ear gets hit by the sound of jazz? Right in the heart of Prague, just 99 meters from Staromestske namesti (square) at 16 Zelezna, you'll find the AghaRTA jazz centrum. AghaRTA is open daily from 6 p.m. through midnight. All that time you can either pick up something for your CD player from the large selection of jazz recordings in our record shop which never closes. Or you can taste the best Prague jazz coffee in AghaRTA bar. Later on it turns strictly into a cozy jazz den with live music, starting from 9 p.m.



Nebe cocktail & music bar, V Celnici 4, Praha 1

Music club Celnice does connect a historical heritage of renaissance cellarge with ultra-modern interior made by popular Czech designer Bara Skorpilova. "The old custom-house" was a main entrance to the Old Town back in the history and even today Celnice Club is the entrance to the best night life in the old Prague. You can taste professionally made cocktails and get lost in the vibrant music of the best world class DJ's. The club is located in very close proximity of hotels Marriott and Renaissance.



LA BODEGUITA DEL MEDIO, Kaprova 5, Praha 1

La Bodeguita is located within a short walking distance from the Old Town Square. Nowadays it belongs to the most popular bars in Prague. From the very beginning La Bodeguita has thrived off a rich social and cultural scene and as such guests can expect to stumble across more than one familiar face. You name it, they supply it: from aromatic and flavoursome Cuban cuisine with succulent steaks and fresh fish to fantastic Caribbean mixed drinks Cuban cigars and first rate entertainment from the Cuban "Quarteta Havana. BUGSY'S BAR, Pařížská 10, Praha 1
